

Powder Coated & Electrolytically Coated Key Clamps & Tube

When unpacking and installing our powder coated key clamps and tube we advise you to be extra careful in handling them to avoid scratching or chipping the surface. Our products are professionally finished but all powder coating can be chipped or scratched if not handled with care.

We provide protection for the products during transportation but the odd chip and or minor marks are sometimes unavoidable and can be rectified on installation with a touch up paint that we provide as an optional extra. This is just like any onsite installation and part of the snagging process.

The grub screws in the clamps can move during transportation and can be in the tightened down position so it is very important to back them off so that none of the screw can be seen within the clamp whilst they are installed onto the tube. If you do not do this and slide them down it can create a scratch all the way down the tube so this is critical to check before installation.

When sliding the clamps down the tube it is always wise to do this slowly and manually support them whilst you are finding the right position again to avoid any damage. If you can, try to be certain in the position of the clamp before tightening the grub screw onto the tube because they are designed to bite into the tube and will make a circular indentation. This can obviously be covered with a touch up paint but its best to avoid this to maintain the best look for the installation.

MINOR CHIPS OR MARKS ARE TO BE EXPECTED ON THESE PRODUCTS SO PLEASE BEAR THIS IN MIND PRIOR TO ANY PURCHASE. THEY CAN BE EASILY COVERED WITH A TOUCH UP PAINT

Although powder coated tubes and fittings can be used in external situations, we recommend they are mainly used for internal applications.
